Tallis, Byrd, Gibbons, Purcell, Wesley, Stainer, Stanford and Howells are all represented, while the choir will also be performing gems by lesser-known composers. The concert will end with the moving *Song for Athene* by the late John Tavener, which was sung at the funeral of Diana, Princess of Wales.
